» Narrow the message down to key points

Make sure to include:

- » A **title** summarizing the key question
- » A **summary** of outcomes
- » A visual display of outcomes
- » Author and abbreviated citation
- » Journal where published
- » Optional: Add images Do not use images without permissions or rights

» Data, using short, descriptive phrases, units, and comparison language
